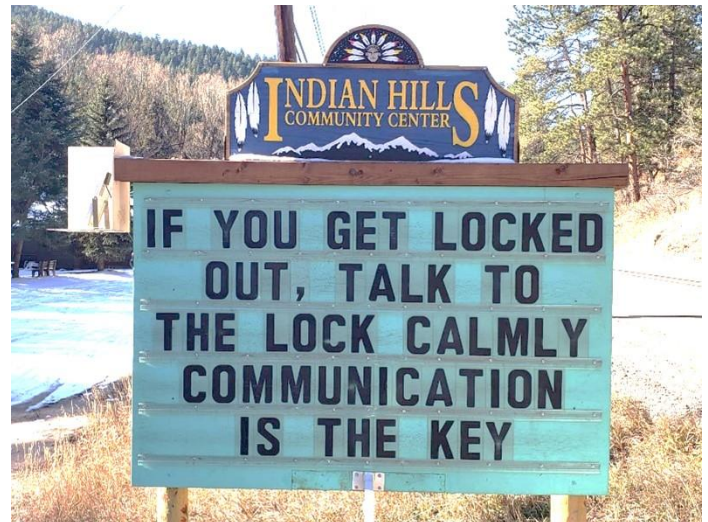

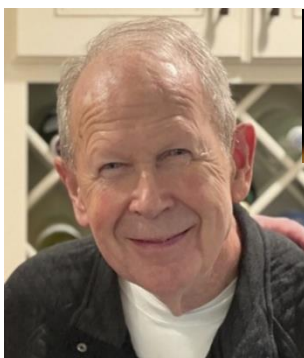
I also want to remind you to set aside June 22<sup>nd</sup> for the Coming Out Party. More information will also grace your inbox shortly, although some details are also below.
